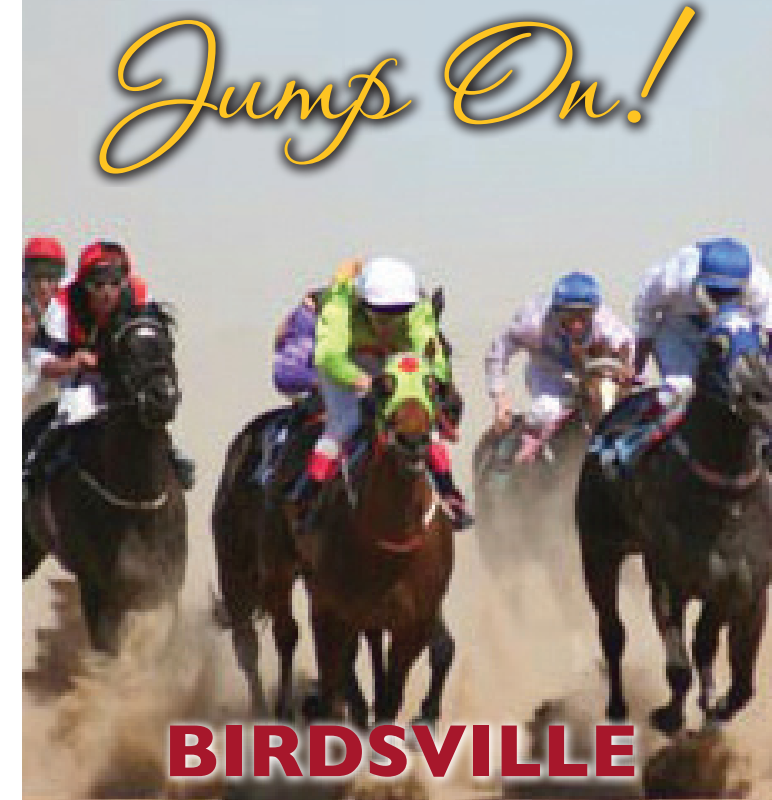

Wednesday 29 August – Monday 2 September 2012



Day One – Wednesday 29th August 2012

Departing the Kangaroo Bus Lines Departure Lounge at 6.00am, we travel via Brisbane, Toowoomba, Dalby, Chinchilla then onto Miles for a KBL picnic lunch. Continuing through, Roma, Mitchell & Morven with comfort stops en-route. Arriving in Charleville this evening for dinner at the Charleville RSL. challenge for visitors. Upon returning to Birdsville, we call at the Birdsville Cemetery which houses many old grave sites of our early pioneers and is testament to the hardships they endured.

The towns population of 80 swells to over 8000, with people coming from all over the country to witness one of Australia's most colourful and exciting sporting and social events. There are street stalls, aerial displays and for those who like a bit of action, Fred Brophy's Boxing Tent.

Lunch will be prepared back at camp before the first race of the day at 1.15pm. After the last race, freshen up before enjoying a well-earned hot dinner prepared on site. This evening you may wish to attend the show at the Birdsville Shire Hall (Dress Codes Apply) or head to the Birdsville Pub for the live entertainment.

Day Four – Saturday 1st September 2012

After breakfast, we travel out to the Diamantina Border, where the Queensland and South Australia borders meet. Lunch will be served back at camp.
