Day One - Wednesday 12th September 2012

An early departure from our Burpengary Lounge at Pitt Road, Burpengary to begin our journey travelling down the Pacific Highway towards Sydney. Day Five - Sunday 16th September 2012

This morning we check out of our accommodation, our coach takes us to the wharf to board the MV Merinda Cruises on the Clyde River for a morning tea cruise. Then it's off to Old Mogo Town which dates back to the 1850's, where you will have time to explore these historic shops, filled with amazing crafts, the Mogo Trading Post, Jenny's old Time lolly shop, and many more old settlers cottages turned into shops. Don't forget to buy your own lunch.

After lunch we continue on to Canberra for a city sights tour before checking into our accommodation at the **Best Western Central Motel, Queanbeyan.** Tonight we attend the Nightfest, Canberra's Floriade at night, this is Australia's way of celebrating Spring. You can take your Floriade Nightfest experience to new heights by taking a ride on the giant 35 meter Ferris Wheel to get those breathtaking views of the park and surrounding cityscape. (Ferris Wheel at your own expense).

Day Six - Monday 17th September 2012

This morning we visit the Floriade, so have your cameras ready for those shots of the beautifully designed and colourful gardens. For lunch today you will have free time to visit the malls to browse some shops.
